INQUISITION

READ: Deuteronomy 19:18-19

And when INQUISITION was made of the matter, it was found out; therefore they were both hanged on a tree: and it was written in the book of the chronicles before the king.

-Esther 2:23 | KJV

Inquisition is a severe interrogation (often violating the rights or privacy of individuals). Inquisition has been tagged as bad by many people because of how others have abused the word. When you are inquisitive about certain matters of others, the feedback you get is that, you should mind your own business. It's good to mind our own businesses but we are entreated to love others like ourselves. When you love others, you inquire about their needs.
